Thoresen has been an invited speaker at many conferences on sustainable human development, education and behavior change, citizenship and social responsibility. She has assisted UNESCO, UNEP and the U.N. Marrakech Process Task Forces in the development of policy recommendations and a core curriculum for education for sustainable consumption. For a number of years she was chairman of the board of the Norwegian Peace Center.
